## **Configure Bananatag for Single Sign-On**

Configuring Bananatag for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Bananatag by using the enterprise credentials.

## Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

## To configure Bananatag for SSO by using SAML:

- 1. In a browser, type <u>https://login.bananatag.com/</u> and press **Enter**.
- 2. Type your Bananatag admin email address and click **NEXT**.



3. Type your Bananatag admin password and click **SIGN IN**.

4. In the dashboard page, click the username in the top-right corner and select **Settings**.

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5. In the **Settings** page, scroll down and click the **Single Sign-On** tile.
