

Configure Cloudability for Single Sign-On


Configuring Cloudability for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Cloudability by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

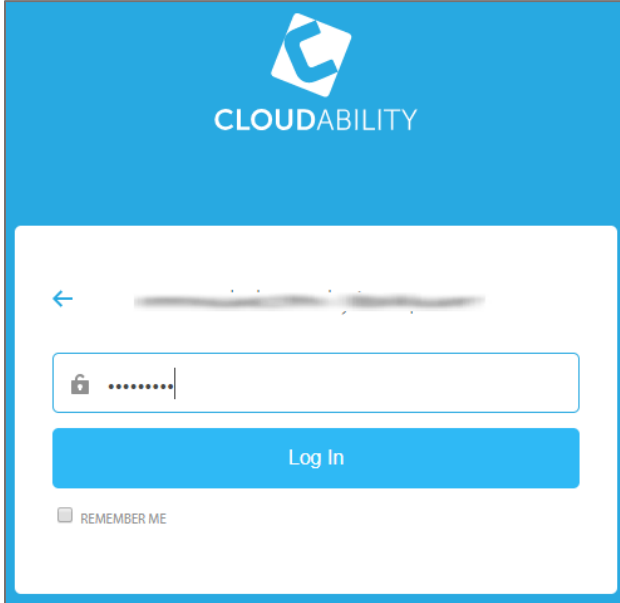
To configure Cloudability for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://app.cloudability.com/login> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your Cloudability admin email address and click **Next**.

3. Type your Cloudability admin password and click **Log In**.



4. To enable and configure SSO, the user must contact Cloudability support team and provide them with the email domain and IdP metadata file in XML format.
