Configuring CloudPassage for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to CloudPassage by using the enterprise credentials.

To configure CloudPassage for SSO by using SAML:

- 1. In a browser, type <u>https://portal.cloudpassage.com/login</u> and press **Enter**.
- 2. Type your CloudPassage admin account credentials (**Username** and **Password**) and click **Enter**.
