Configuring Contentful for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix Gateway service. Users can securely log on to Contentful by using the enterprise credentials.

## To configure Contentful for SSO by using SAML:

- 1. In a browser, type <u>https://be.contentful.com/login</u> and press **Enter**.
- 2. Enter your Contentful admin account credentials (Email and Password) and click Log in.
