Configuring Dmarcian for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Dmarcian by using the enterprise credentials.

- 1. In a browser, type <u>https://dmarcian.com/login/</u> and press **Enter**.
