
Configuring Hosted Graphite for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Hosted Graphite by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

To configure Hosted Graphite for SSO by using SAML:

- 1. In a browser, type <u>https://www.hostedgraphite.com/</u> and press **Enter**.
- 2. Type your Hosted Graphite admin account credentials (**Email address** and **Password**) and click **Log in**.



3. In the dashboard page, click **Access** from the left pane and select **SAML Setup**.
