Configuring intelligent contract for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to intelligent contract by using the enterprise credentials.

To configure intelligentcontract for SSO by using SAML:

- 1. In a browser, type <u>https://portal.intelligentcontract.com/en-gb/</u> and press **Enter**.
- 2. Type your intelligent contract admin account credentials (**Username** and **Password**) and click **Sign In**.



3. In the dashboard page, click the Settings icon in the lower-left corner.
