


Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

To configure Ziflow for SSO by using SAML:


- 1. In a browser, type https://www.ziflow.io/#/login/ and press Enter.
- 2. Type your Ziflow admin account credentials (**E-mail address** and **Password**) and click **Sign** in.



3. In the dashboard page, click the user account in the top-right corner and select **Manage** account.




4. Click **Single Sign-On** from the left pane.



5. In the **Single Sign-On** page, enter the values for the following fields:
