

Configuring DigiCert


Configuring DigiCert for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to DigiCert by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above


To configure DigiCert for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://www.digicert.com/> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your DigiCert admin account credentials (**Username** and **Password**) and click **LOGIN**.

4. In the left panel, click **Single Sign On** and enter the values for the following fields:
