

Configuring Feedly


Configuring Feedly for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Feedly by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite


Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

To configure Feedly for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://feedly.com/> and press **Enter**.
2. In the home page, click **LOG IN** at the top-right corner and select **Continue with feedly**.



5. In the **Users** page, you can view the list of added users.
