Configuring Happyfox

Configuring Happyfox for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Happyfox by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

To configure Happyfox for SSO by using SAML:

- 1. In a browser, type <u>https://your company domain.happyfox.com/</u> and press **Enter**.
- 2. On the home page, click **LOGIN**.
- 3. Type your Happyfox admin credentials (Username/Email and Password) and click Login.
