

Configuring MuleSoft

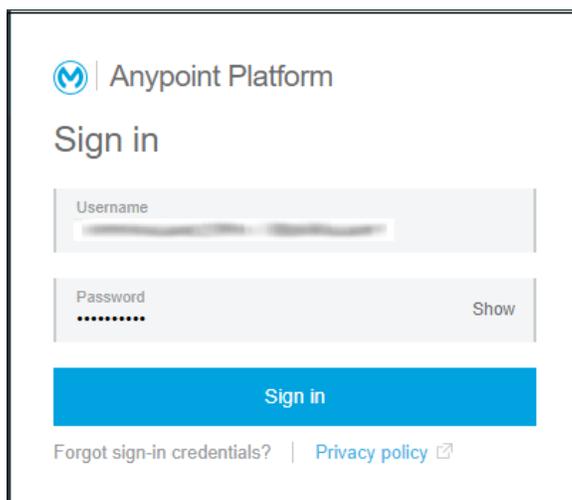
Configuring MuleSoft for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to MuleSoft by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

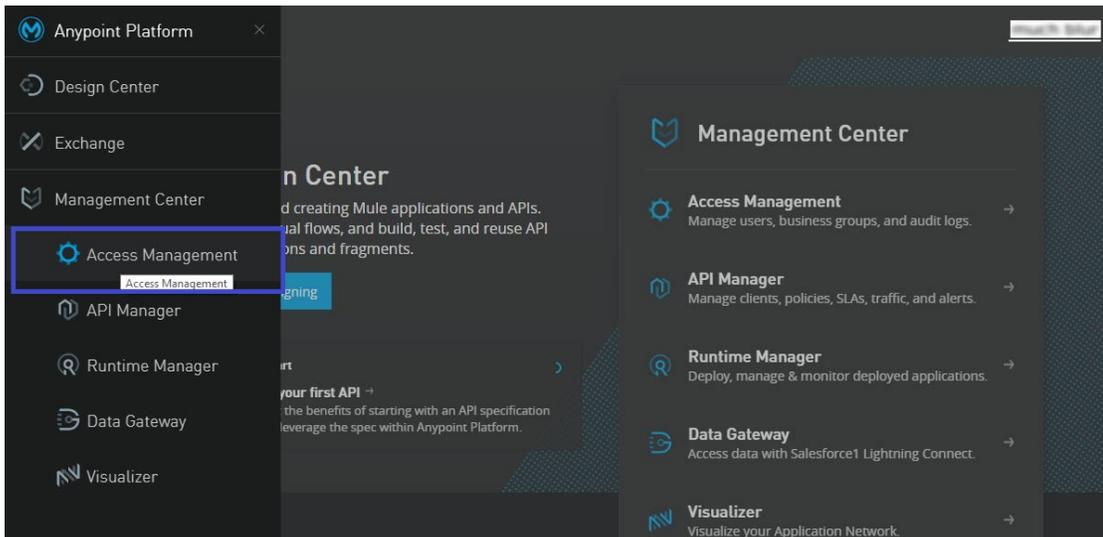
To configure MuleSoft for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <https://www.mulesoft.com> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your MuleSoft admin account credentials (**Username** and **Password**) and click **Sign in**.

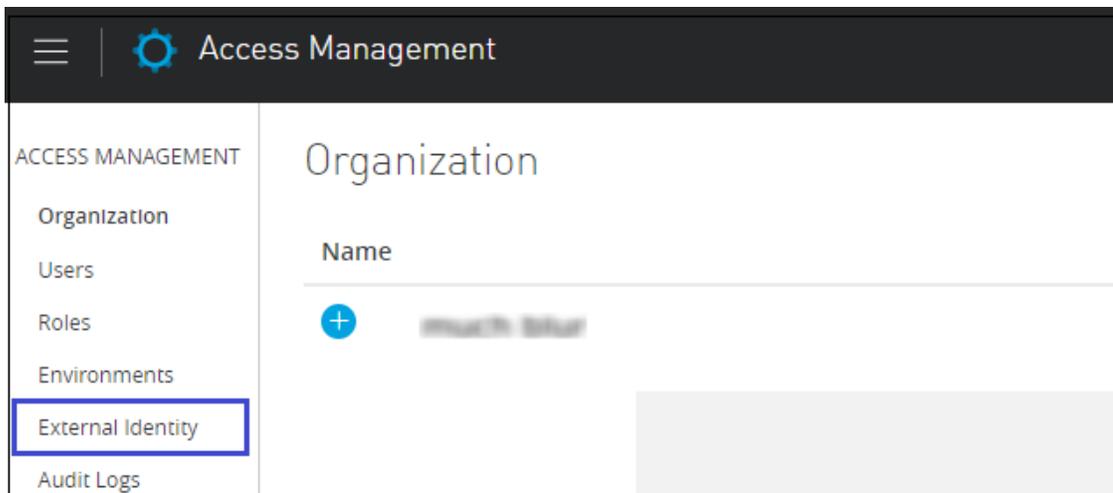
