Configuring Rackspace

Rackspace for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to Rackspace by using the enterprise credentials.

- 1. In a browser, type <u>https://rackspace.com</u> and press **Enter**.
- 2. On the home page, click **Log In**.
- 3. In the **Cloud Control Panel tile**, click **Login**.
