

Configuring TwentyThree


Configuring TwentyThree for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on to TwentyThree by using the enterprise credentials.

Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

To configure TwentyThree for SSO by using SAML:

1. In a browser, type <http://www.twentythree.net/> and press **Enter**.
2. Type your TwentyThree admin account credentials (**Email address** and **Password**) and click **Log In**.





3. In the top-right corner, click the Settings icon and select **Access** from the drop-down list.



4. In the **Access** page, select the **Single sign-on or Paywall** option.



5. In the **Access** page, scroll down and enter the values for the following fields:

Field Name	Description
Remote login URL	IdP logon URL
Remote logout URL	IdP logout URL

Remote authentication

Remote login URL

If you want to redirect un-authenticated users to login page, enter the link here. This page should be designed to log in and authenticate users through your preferred identity system – and then delegate access to this site through [our single sign-on API](#).

Remote logout URL

If you want users to log out using a specific URL, enter it here.

Create visitor accounts? No, SSO should only sign sessions, not create visitor accounts.
 Yes, SSO should create a visitor account on TwentyThree when possible.
Creating visitor account can be helpful in tracking for example comments, live registrations and open uploads.

Allow back-end login? No, SSO should only be used for my front-end site.
 Yes, SSO log users into the back-end if the person is already set up with an account.
The single sign-on mechanism is designed to grant people access to published content on your video website. Optionally, you can choose to let people be logged in to the backend if a user account has already been created with their e-mail address.

6. Finally, click **Save**.

Note: To configure SSO, reach out to the TwentyThree customer support and provide them with the metadata URL. The support team will configure the SP from the backend.
