## **Configuring UserVoice**

Configuring UserVoice for single sign-on (SSO) enables administrators to manage users of Citrix ADC. Users can securely log on UserVoice by using the enterprise credentials.

## Prerequisite

Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 11 and above

## To configure UserVoice for SSO by using SAML:

- 1. In a browser, type <u>https://customer\_domain.uservoice.com</u> and press **Enter**.
- 2. Type your UserVoice admin credentials (Email and Password) and click Sign in.
